#### Our Topic How to establish Child Labour Free Zones

- A child labour free zone is a defined area, such as a village or a plantation or a institutional area, where everyone is convinced that 'No child should be working, every child should be in school!'
- Teachers, local authorities, village leaders, employers, parents and children in these zones work together to get children out of work and into school.
- Child labour is no longer accepted because all children are entitled to good, full-time education.

## **CHILD LABOUR FREE ZONE**

- The CLFZ concept originates in Ranga\_Reddy, where MV\_Foundation\_began working activities on the issue of child labour in 1971 in Rajasthan ARAVALI leading this process.
- Has now developed into worldwide Stop Child Labour movement with many faces and features.

 CLFZ projects:India,Uganda ,Ghana,Kenya, Zimbabwe,Morocco,Ethiopa,Mali,Senegal, Burkin Faso, Nicaragua,Turkey.





#### Area based approach- Child Labour Free Zone

- This approach build upon following
   Principles
  - All children must attained formal full time school.
  - Any children out school is a ( potential ) child labour.
  - Any justification of child labour must be condemned.
  - Parent wants a better future for their children.





#### **FIELD WORK** Child right department

- Visited the child right department, Jaipur .
- we had a conversation with Mr. Anirudh, he explain about the child labour act 1986
- According to act 1986 had prohibited the employment of children below age of 14 in hazardous occupation identified in a list by the law which has been revised in 2016. The number of hazardous occupations and processes has been reduced from 83 to only 3.





#### CHILD WELFARE COMMITTEE

It is the sole authority to deal with matters concerning children in need of care and protection.

It follow the following procedure:

•They rescue children from the clutches of unscrupulous employers.

• then they are repatriated to there native place till repatriation they are kept in shelter homes or children's home

# Recent rescue


Twenty-seven child labourers, have been rescued from a bread factory in Anantpura Jaipur.

- children, aged between 14 and 17 years, were made to work for over 12 hours a day in hazardous conditions.
- The raid was carried out by anti-human trafficking unit .
- 25 of the rescued children were from Bihar and two from Uttar Pradesh. They were brought to work here by a private contractor about two months ago.

- "The children were found working as bonded labourers in hazardous conditions. They wore old, torn clothes even in the cold conditions. They were being given little food.
  - A case were later produced before the Child Welfare Committee (CWC) that sent them to shelters homes.
- A case has been lodged against the owner of the bread factory and the private contractor.

#### FACTS ABOUT CHILD LABOUR

- One in every 11 children in India is work.
- Child labour has been decreasing at the rate of 2.2% per year from 2001 to 2011.
- 80% of working children are based in rural area.
- More child labour are done in 5 state Bihar ,Uttar Pradesh ,Rajasthan , Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.
