
Half The Sky

 - Elevating women <u>AND</u> also their children and communities







Legal and Social Awareness

Conduct Legal workshops to educate women about current laws for women e.g. Domestic Violence Act 2005, Child Marriage Act, Immoral Trafficking Prevention Act, Dowry Act

Help Gender Sensitization through Street play performance and discussions for the whole community

Run Family Counseling Centers to help women subjected to domestic violence through legal, financial, social, police involvement



Child marriages now down to less than 10% – most marry at or after 18; 3158 cases of women registered, 2641 are settled. Unique decision for Dowry in 11 Gram Panchayats, 19 marriages without it.

Reached more than 200,000 people including 53,000 women for the leadership building training.

Governance Awareness

 Educate women on the Rights and Duties of elected women in the local governments (village councils)

- 20 to 30% women now actually involved and performing their duties
- More than 50% women in the local governments now sit at the table – instead on the floor
- About 50% of the women 'Sarpanch' (leaders) now perform flag hoisting – compared to **none** before

 Mahila Gram Sabha (Town Hall meetings – attended only by women, focused on the community problems)

- Now, in most villages the meetings actually take place – unlike before
- Now, 50% or more women attend these meetings

The numbers keep climbing – as we continue to raise the legal and governance awareness! Women from SHGs are Sarpanch.

Health and Sex Education

~ 200,000 People from 152 villages Educated on health problems

Up to 85% (from 35%) households now use permanently installed in-house toilets

Use of tested purified water increased to 50%

Anemia cases now down to less than 5% and whole family health improvement through Kitchen Gardens

100% Vaccinations

100% use of iodized salt instead of raw salt

37,000 people educated on TB symptoms and prevention with Direct Observed Treatment (DOTS)

Adolescent girls' health and sex education including HIV/AIDS awareness-13370 boys and girls educated
