

The lack of affordable sanitary pads has been widely cited as one of the key obstacles to regular school attendance among young girls & for various diseases/infections. So, we have taken the initiative of providing a pack of 8 sanitary pads to maximum girls/ladies each month to spread awareness about health and hygiene.

DAY - 7 CULTURAL DAY, MOVIE SCREENING WITH SNACKS


Organized a movie show and served maggi, snacks & soft drinks


