


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MEWAT : HEALTH INDICATORS

- •Low literacy rate (44.07%)
- •Very low female literacy (24.26%)
- •Poor Female Male sex ratio (894 /1000)
- Poor access to health services
- Very low institutional deliveries
- •Females do not access RCH services
- Immunization among children is very low
- Lack of health related services in the area
- •Poor knowledge on menstrual hygiene and personal hygiene.
- •Lack of awareness on sanitation.




OBJECTIVE OF RURAL HEALTH

Promoting Health conscious communities, so that there is an improvement in their health, especially RCH, hygiene and sanitation and utilization of health care.



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
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
