A New awareness campaign was supported today by Raksha at the 21st Birding Fair at Man sagar lake(Jaipurs birding site) dedicated to White Naped Tit.

Over 1500 students from various schools participated in the event. Today we started the awareness program for saving animals through roadkills. The campaign aimed at educating citizens to download and record roadkills through ROAD WATCH app.

Every single person whom we spoke to agreed to the fact many animals die in road kills but there is little what they can do.....so when we talked about the app and its benefits in the near future everybody was willing to download the app and record data so that in the near future we can have preventive measures coming in like reduced speed limit, bridges, alternate routes etc.

FACTS AND FIGURES

- Around 500 Rock Pigeons and 300 other birds are rescued every year by team **RAKSHA**.
- Approximately 500 snakes and reptiles are rescued and immediately released to the forest area except in case of medication.
- Every year during Makar sakranti **RAKSHA** organises a medication camp for birds injured due to manjha.



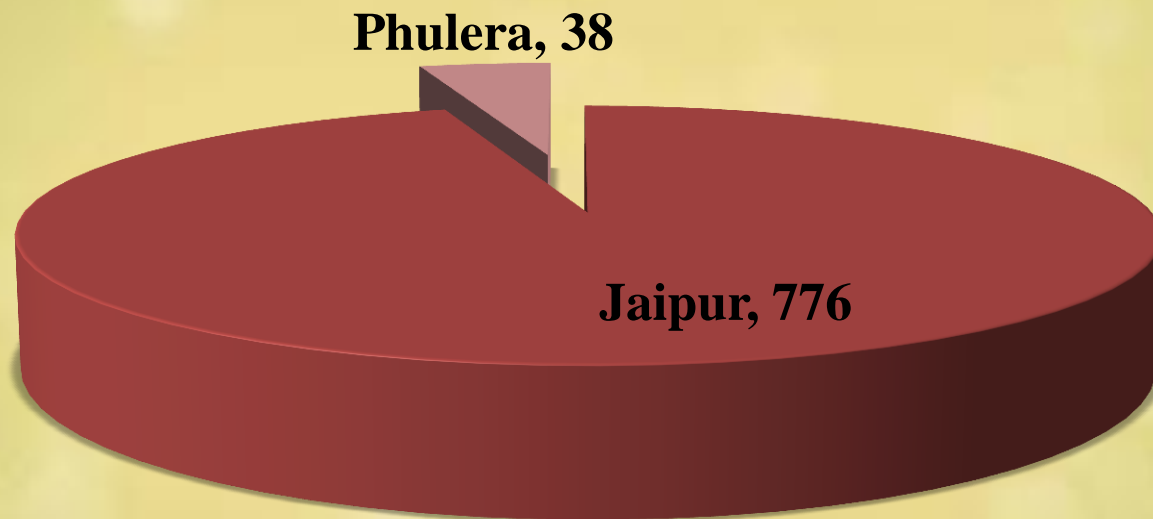
