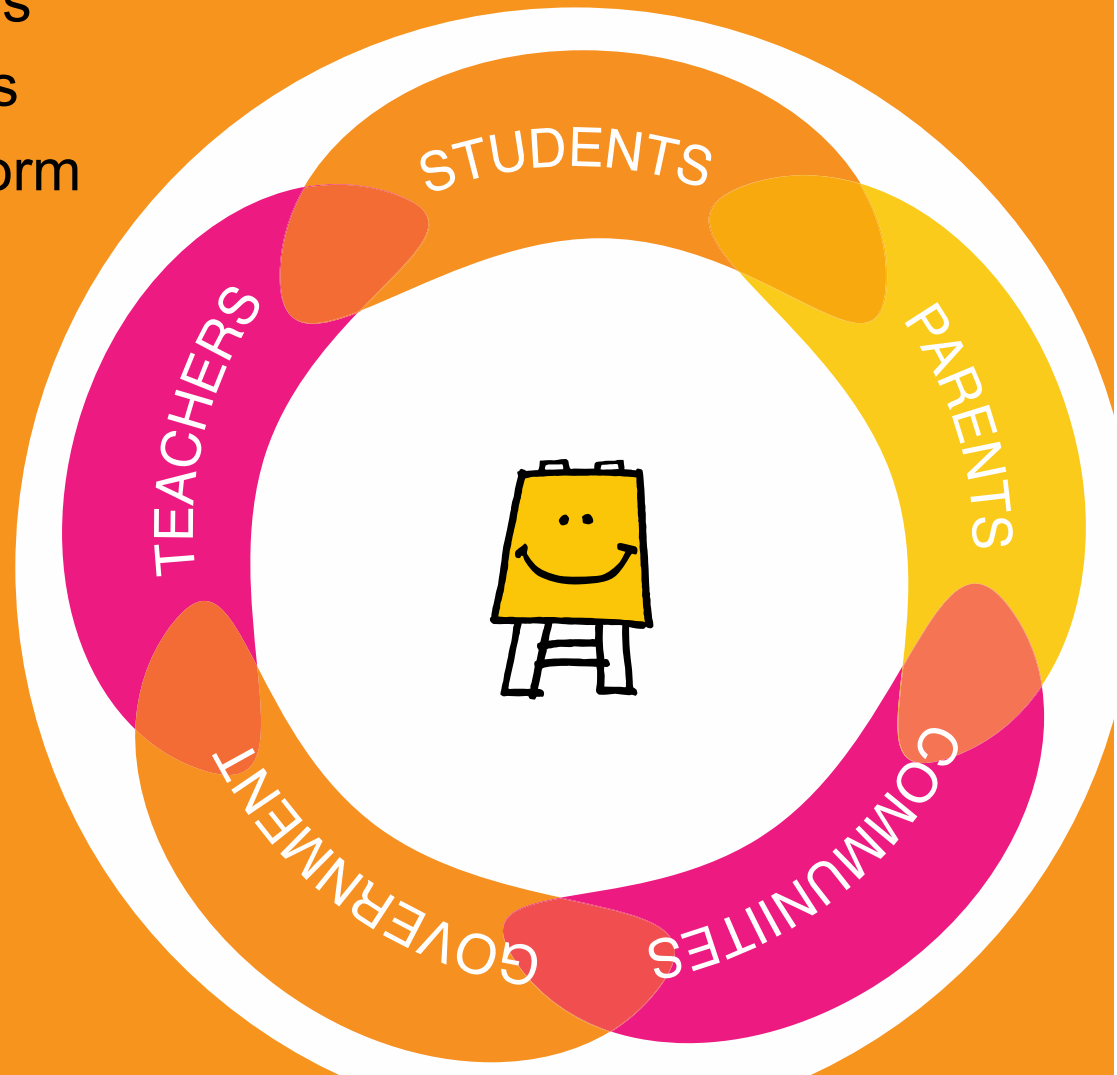

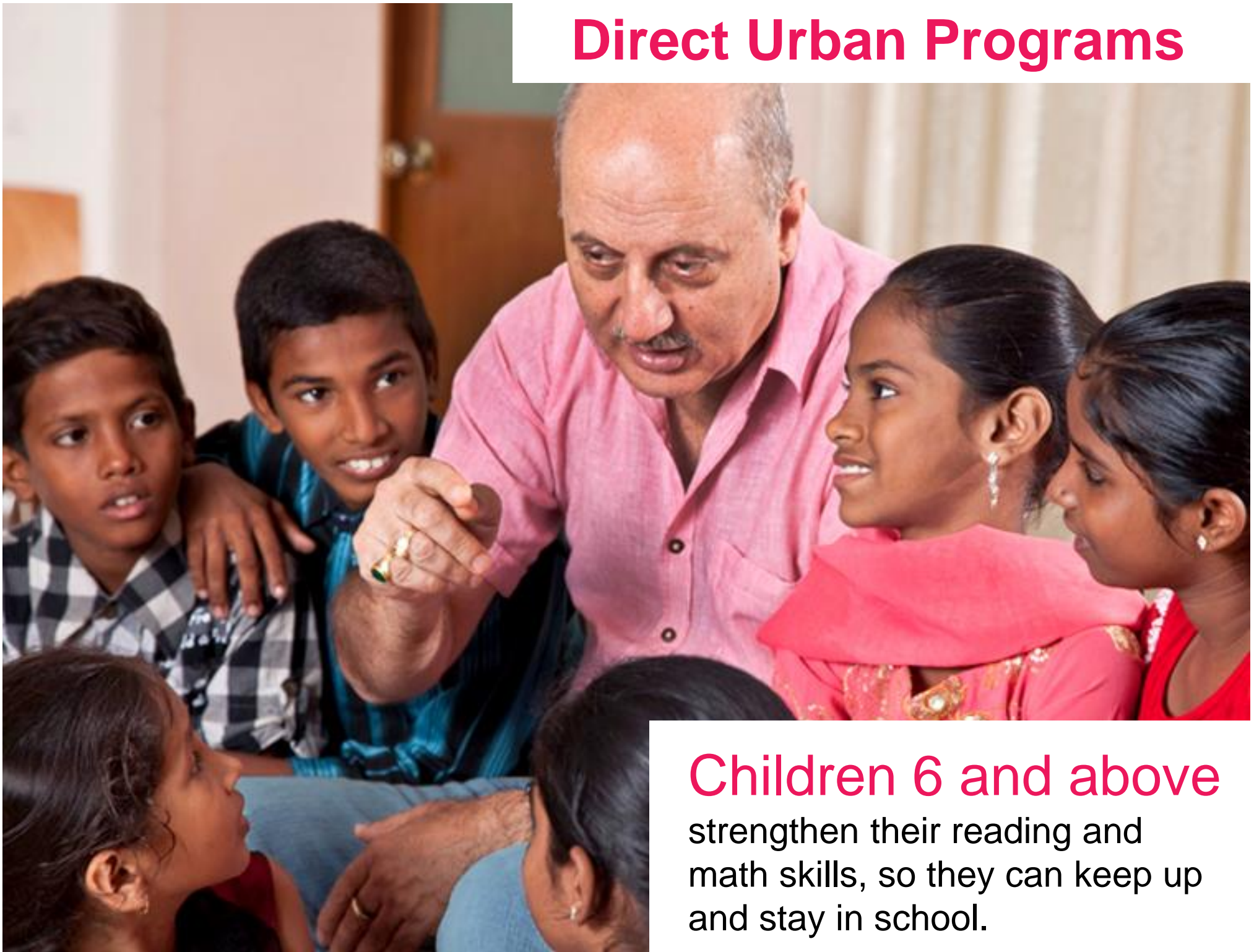


Read India

Vocational Skills Program



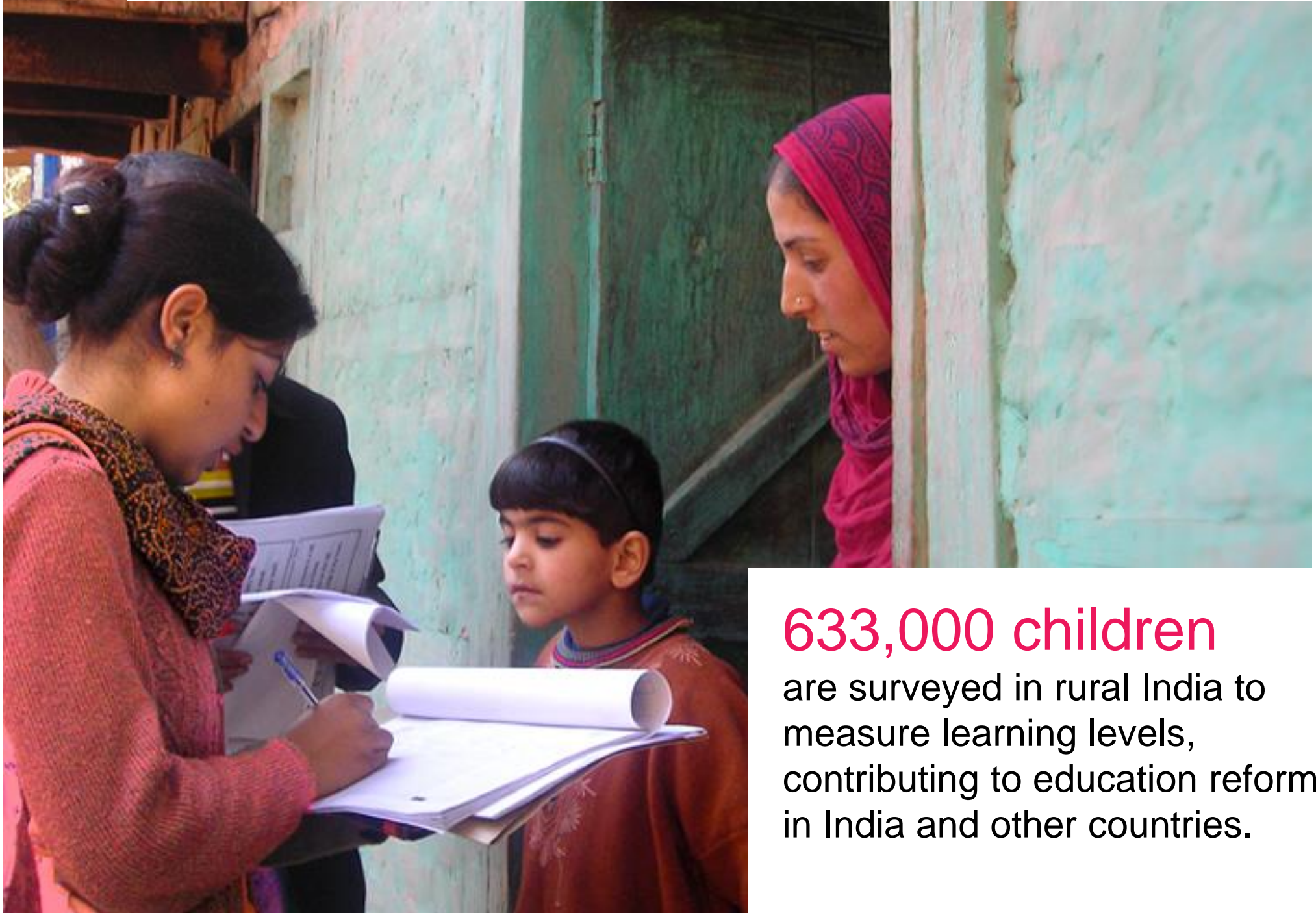
Over **54,000 youth** now have skills to enter the workforce.

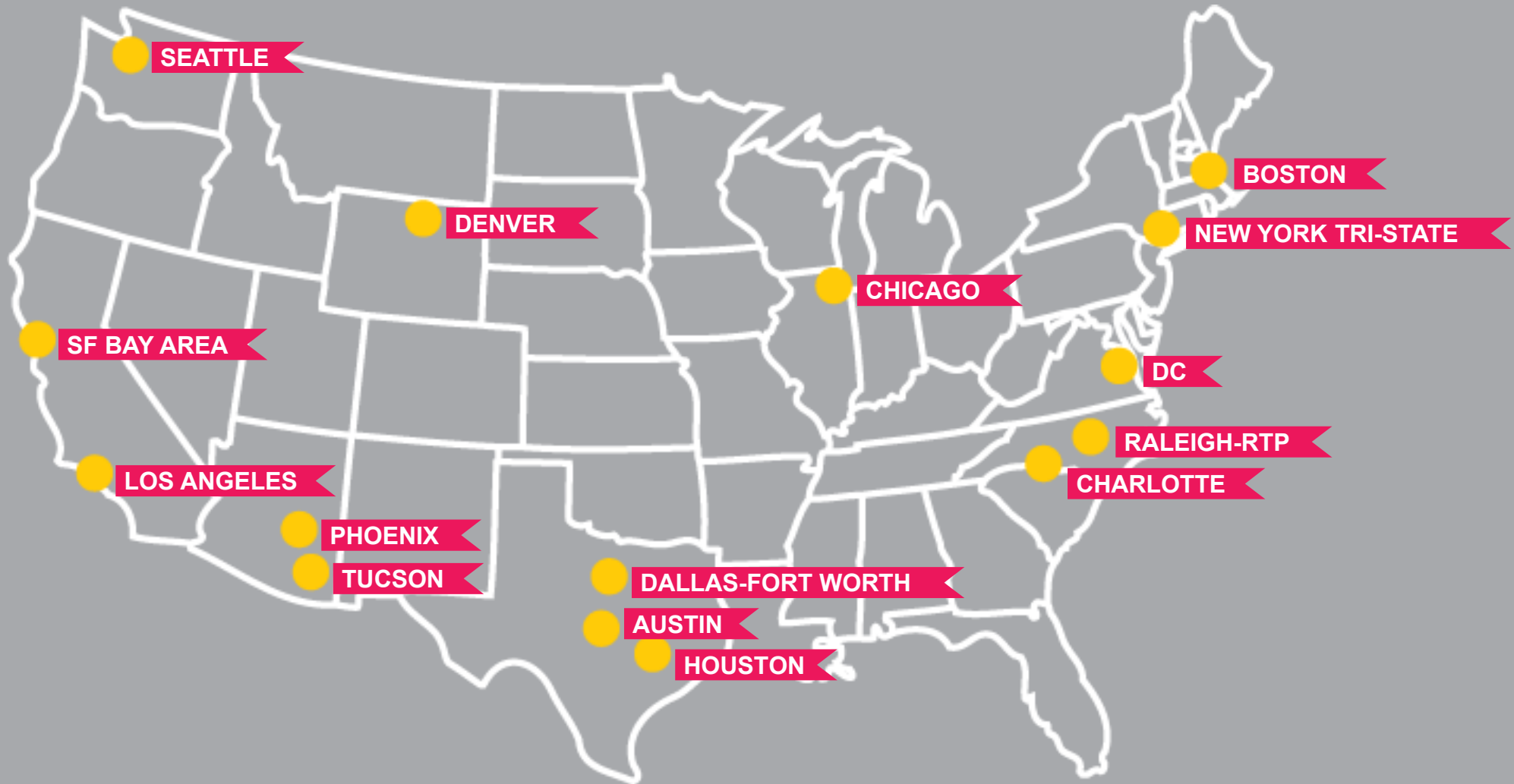

Pratham's Chapters in the U.S.



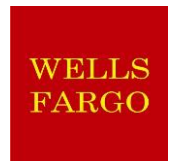
Pratham is in 15 cities with over 1,000 dedicated volunteers promoting Pratham's cause within their communities.
